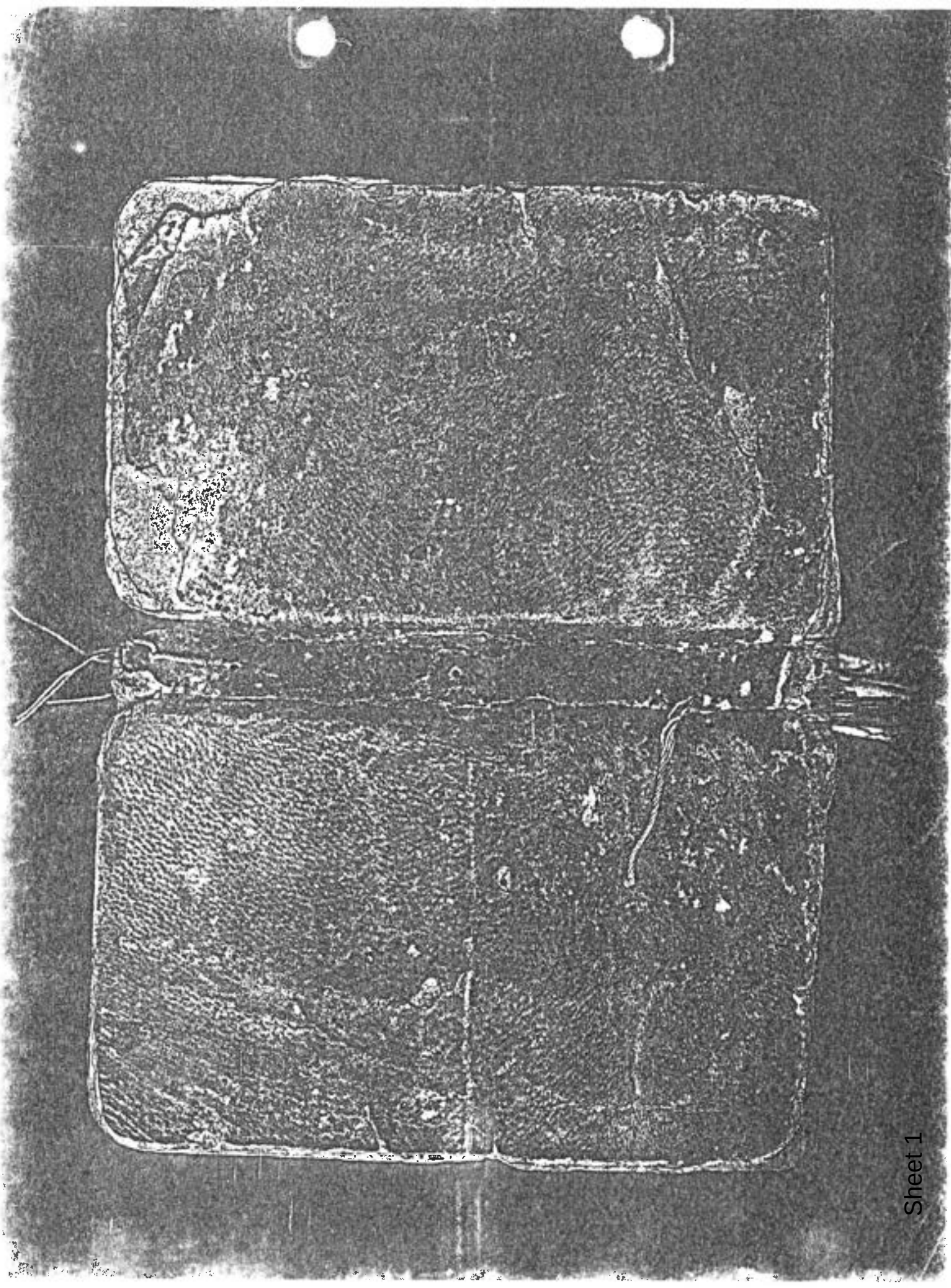




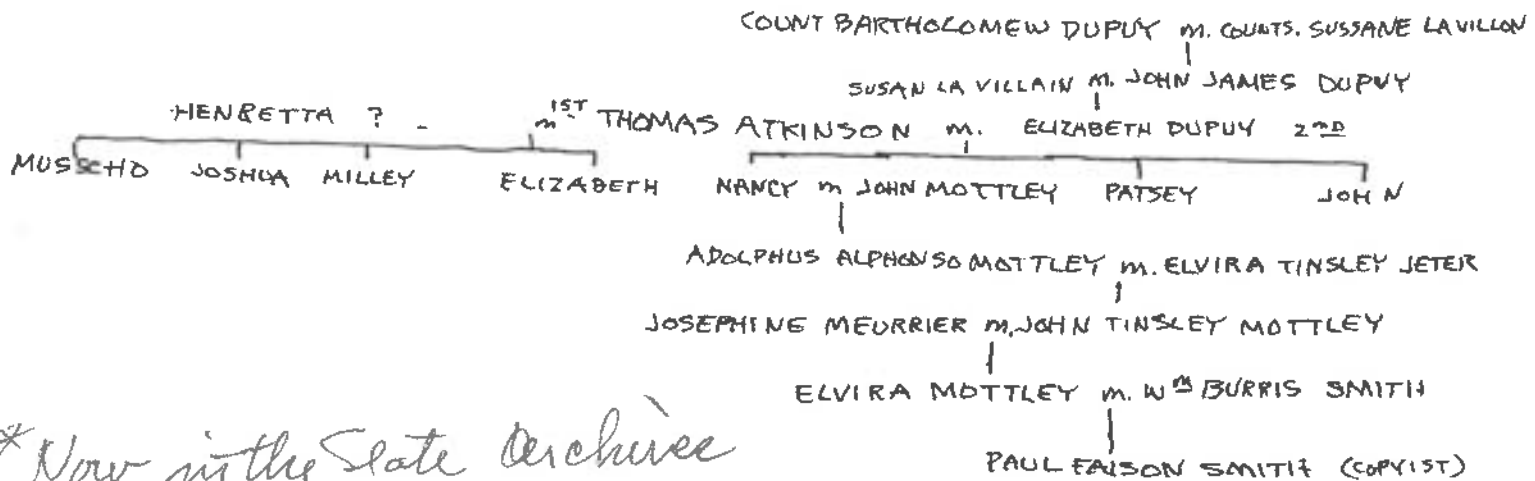
PREFACE
